

How2 download Kodu Game Lab

Kodu Game Lab is a free program from Microsoft that allows you to create your own games and play them, either on a computer or on the Xbox. You can use both a keyboard and mouse, or an Xbox controller to create and play the games.

Your teacher will download Kodu for you to use in your TechFuture Girls club, but once you start to use this great program, you will probably want to continue to use it at home! This how2 explains how you download Kodu for your own use. Check with your mum or dad first, though, before downloading it!

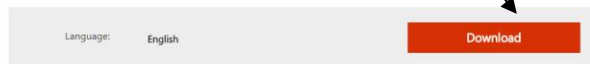

Kodu Game Lab



Kodu is a visual programming language made specifically for creating games.

When the download ends, a dialogue box might appear asking you whether to 'run' or 'save'. Click 'save' and this will put a copy of the program on to your hard drive. If the download appears in the bottom left of your browser window, click on it to install.

Go to the Start menu to find the new installation and click on it. You can also put a shortcut on your desktop (right click, select Create Shortcut), or pin the program to your Start Menu or Taskbar.
